Uniform

Please ensure that your child is wearing the correct PE uniform on PE days. As the weather gets colder, if wearing tracksuit bottoms, they should be <u>plain navy</u> and the school jumper or navy hoodie may be worn on colder days. Remember black shoes should be worn with full school uniform. Girls should wear navy tights with full school uniform and NOT navy leggings and white socks. Thank you.

Health

As we move into the colder weather, we are expecting children to get the usual colds and viral infections. Please assess your children carefully, you know them best and know if they are fit for school. In many cases, children with colds will be well enough to attend school and continue their learning with little or no interruption to their education. We would just ask that you remind them of good respiratory hygiene. In other cases, for instance, where they have quite a heavy cold or a flu, they may need to take a day or two off to recover.



Please refer to the 'Guidance on Infection Control in Schools' for advice on whether your child needs to be kept at home following an illness or period of vomiting etc. this is a very useful poster to refer to. You will find it on the website- Parents' Area- letters.

Children should not attend school if they appear unwell or have been vomiting. If you child has had diarrhoea and/or vomiting the recommended period to be kept away from school is **48 hours** from their last episode of diarrhoea or vomiting.

Covid If a child tests positive for COVID-19, they should stay at home and avoid contact with other people for 3 days. This starts from the day after they did the test. Children and young people tend to be infectious to others for less time than adults.
